I set my face like a FLINT, and I know, I will never be put to shame



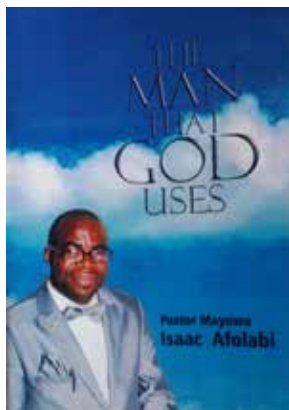

He got the appointment as the Director of Health and Substance Abuse for the Detroit Urban League where he led the city of Detroit in substance abuse prevention initiative and was rewarded with the distinguished position of the Director, Bureau of Substance Abuse for the city of Detroit where he was in charge of the city's \$35 million budget on Substance Abuse. He managed the city's Target city's project grant of \$12 million from the Federal government. Then proceeded to take the position as Professor of Public Health Education since 2001. His scholarly and amiable accomplishments could be summarized as follows:

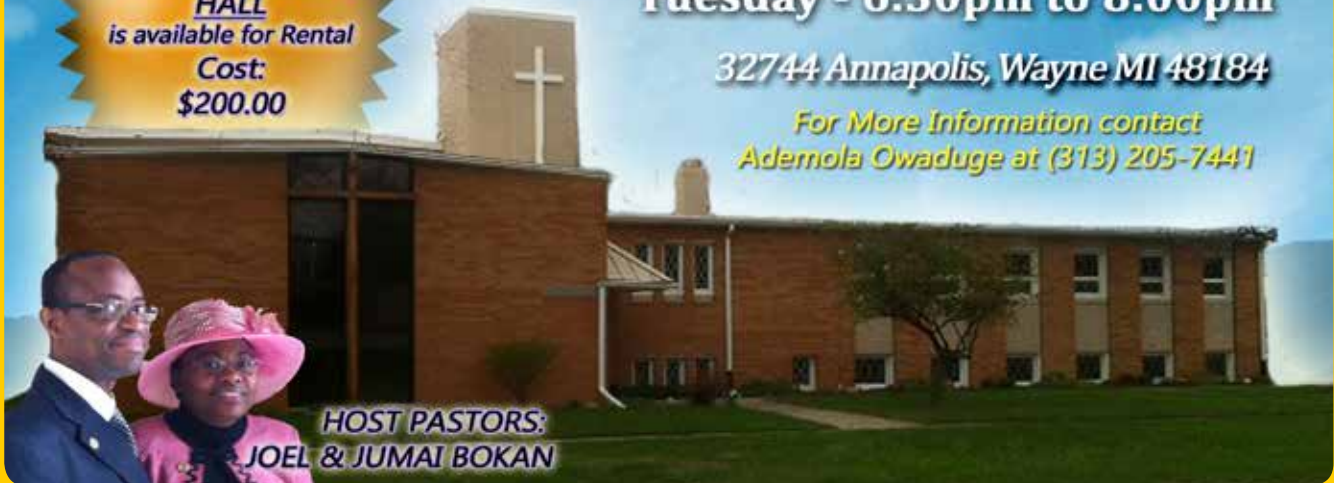

MARRIAGE FAILURES

It can be extremely difficult for two people to begin a relationship, sustaining that relationship can sometimes be a challenge. We all have our faults and flaws, our marks of imperfection and as two people come to know each other, the flaws become more pronounced. Why has it become so difficult for couples to stay together?

The struggle to survive in marriage requires adaptability, genuine love, kindness, flexibility and God Grace to say the least. Most often times, we pretend that a new partner will solve the old problems. Infidelity might just be a symptom of trouble, while dishonesty, cheating and hiding can create walls between couples. Divorce might not necessarily be an evil act as it might provide salvation for couples who have grown hopelessly apart, undergoing mutual unhappiness and grown patterns of pain. The numbers of failed marriages can be easily quantified only if statistics can measure loneliness, regret, loss of self-confidence, fear, and pain.

Marriage failures can not necessarily be assign to outside weather but in most cases it can result from inner climate becoming too hot or too cold. Most marriages have crisis points and each has to undergo tests of endurance and capacity for change. Most of us fall in love with our partner while still carrying the qualities of our parents, masculinity, and femininity as models for our marriage. Even though most failed marriage is unique but we can still find common perils to relate to. Environmental or outside pressures like illness, infertility, job loss, care of the aged parents, difficulty

raising children are common hurricanes that can blast our shores. Some marriages can survive these storms if their foundation is solid while others are blown away due to their faulty foundation.

Our modern social fabric is quite thin which has created unrealistic expectations that have thrown so many families into chaos. Balancing separateness and closeness is one major psychological task in every facet of life as advocated by Dr. Stuart Brtle, a Psychiatrist with New York University Medical Center while Dr. Carl A. Whitaker, a marital therapist and emeritus professor of Psychiatry at University of Wisconsin explains that marriage requires sexual, financial and emotional discipline. Divorce is so common today because couples are unwilling to exercises that are required for marriages to work.

Marriages require some kind of sacrifice and compromise. While individual partner may feel shackled a times in sustaining a marriage. As I recollect the various experiences that our relationship has undergone, I must say that we have come to care about each other, trustworthy, reliable to each other and make God our third cord that tie us both together and not any external friend.

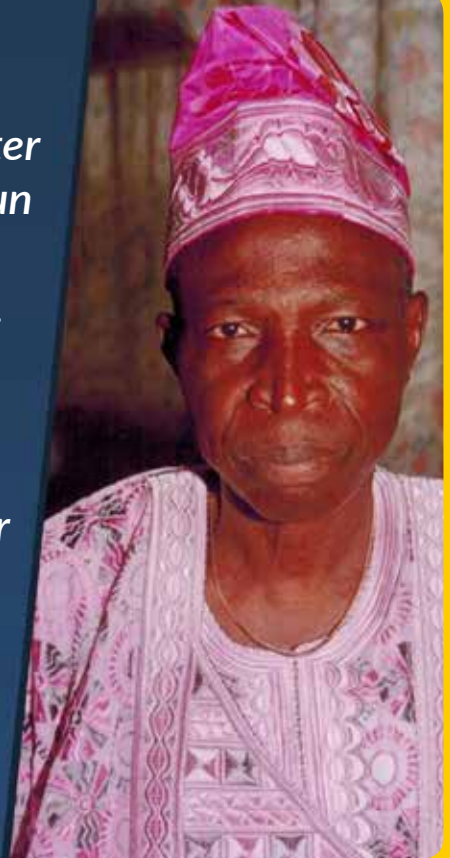

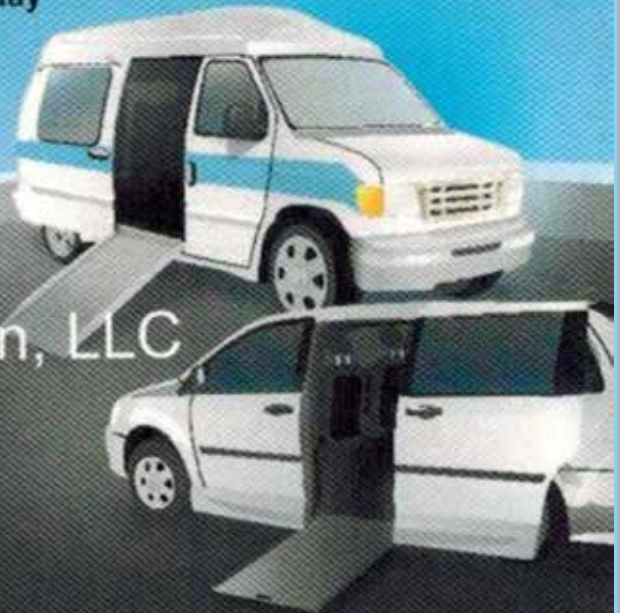

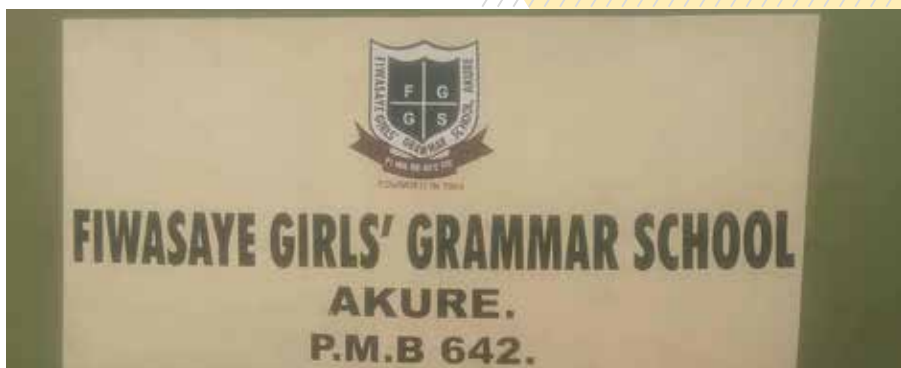


FIWASAYE GIRLS GRAMMAR SCHOOL

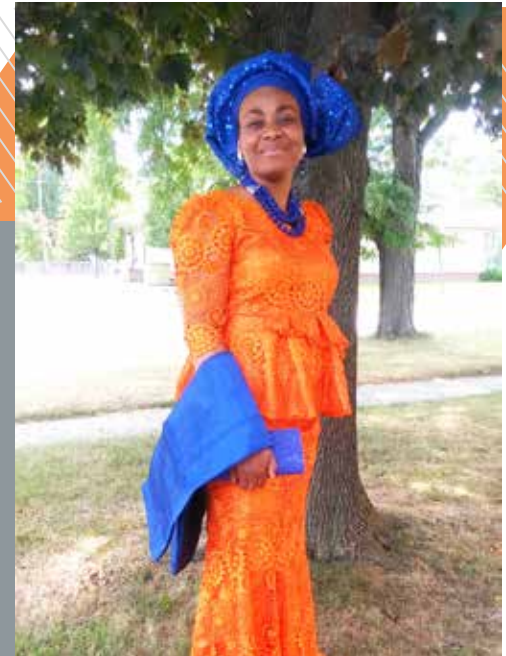

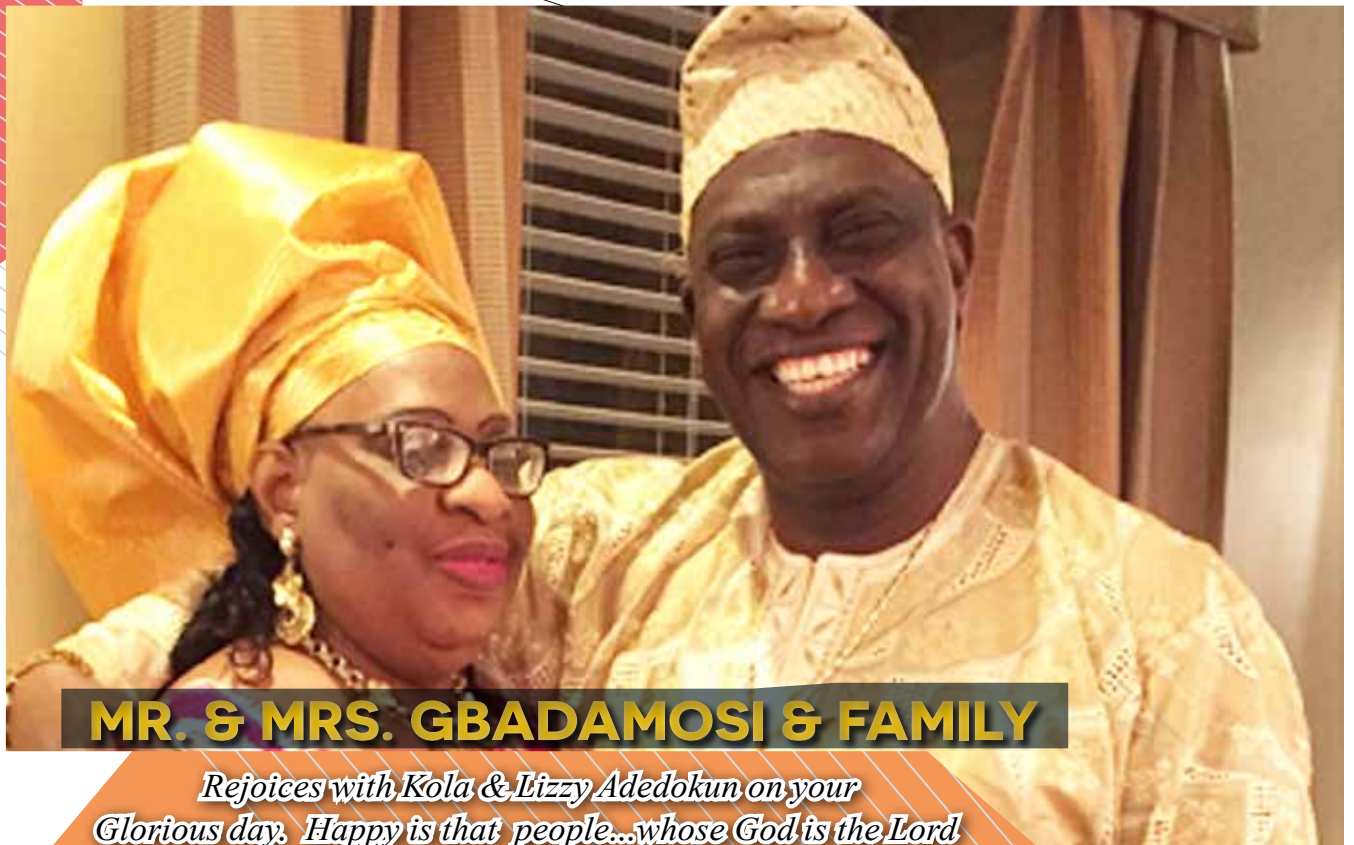
